

SWIMMER CODE OF CONDUCT

As Dolphins swimmer, I will abide by the following code of conduct:

- I will respect and show courtesy to my teammates and coaches at all times.
- I will practice teamwork with all teammates and coaches.
- I will show good sportsmanship by conducting myself in a manner that earns the respect of my teammates, other swimmers, parents, officials and the coaches at all meets and practices.
- I will set a good example of behavior and work ethic for my younger teammates.
- I will be respectful of my teammates' feelings and personal space. Swimmers who exhibit sexist, racist, homophobic, or otherwise inappropriate behavior will be faced with consequences.
- I will show respect for all facilities and other property (including locker rooms) used during practices, competitions, and team activities.
- I will refrain from foul language, violence, behavior deemed dishonest, offensive, or illegal (including drug, alcohol, and tobacco use).
- I will maintain self-control at all times.
- I will enjoy involvement with the Dolphins by supporting the other swimmers & coaches with positive communications & actions.
- During competitions, questions or concerns regarding decisions made by meet officials are directed to a member of our coaching staff or a board member.
- During competitions and other team activities, I will remember that I am representing our team and my actions will be positive and free from negative actions.
- I understand that criticizing, name-calling, use of abusive language, cursing or gestures directed toward the coaches, officials, &/or any participating swimmer will not be permitted or tolerated.
- I also understand that social media is never the place to criticize our coaches, our swimmers, other teams, other swimmers, officials and any other people involved with the Dolphins Swim Team.

I understand that any action in violation of the swimmer code of conduct will have consequences appropriate to the violation. Those consequences may range from verbal warning about violation, parent contact, removal from practice, parent/board meeting, or other actions deemed necessary for the safety of the athlete/athletes present. I also understand that the continuation of a violation may result in the removal from the team.
